Details of Participation

Information on how to enter forms part of these Details of Participation and entry is deemed as acceptance of them. No purchase is necessary to enter the contest or redeem prizes. Contest commences on Tuesday 1st August and entries close at 5pm AEDST on Sunday 10th September 2017. Entries not received by that date or not completed in accordance with the Details of Participation will not be eligible to win.

Prize

13 photos will be selected. Each winning photographer will receive a \$100 voucher for the Heart Foundation online shop.

Total prize pool is valued at \$1300. If any prize is unavailable, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute another item for the prize, in its sole discretion, of equal or higher value. All prize values are correct at the time of printing. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash unless otherwise indicated.

Who can enter?

Contest is open to all registered members of the Heart Foundation Walking program in all States and Territories of Australia. The photographer must be a registered member of the Heart Foundation Walking program and cannot be a professional photographer. Employees of the Promoter and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.

How to enter

Contest can be entered either by one of two ways:

1. Completing the Heart Foundation Walking Photographic Competition entry form available at <http://walking.heartfoundation.org.au/news-events/current-promotions/> during the period of the competition and returning the entry form and photograph to walking@heartfoundation.org.au by email.

A valid entry form must:

- Have a fully complete entry form, including a description of the image in 25 words or less;
- Ensure each person featured in the image is a registered Heart Foundation Walking participant and has agreed to their image being taken for the purposes of this competition;
- Submit the photograph as a high resolution jpeg file of at least 300dpi at 120mmx120mm or larger, with a maximum file size of 5MB;

OR

Submit your photo via social media. On Twitter by tagging #HeartAust, or by tagging @heartfoundationwalking on Facebook or Instagram and using the hashtags #justwalkit and #HFWcomp16 including a description of the image in 25 words or less.

If you enter via social media HFW will only be in touch should you be selected as a winner. You will then be required to submit the photograph as a high resolution jpeg file of at least 300dpi at 120mmx120mm or larger, with a maximum file size of 5MB and complete the entry form.

Judging

This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner/s.

Entries will be judged based on creative merit, uniqueness and inspirational qualities by a panel of judges with the top 13 entries receiving a prize. Judges decision is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into. The photos will be published in the 2018 HFW calendar. One photo will be selected for the front cover, each calendar month will feature a different photo (13 in total). The placement of the photos in the calendar is at the discretion of the Promoter and the calendar designer. The photos may require cropping.

Neither the Promoter nor any of their agencies are responsible for lost, late, damaged, misdirected, incomplete or ineligible entries. Judging will take place between Monday 11th and Friday 15th September at 155 Hutt Street, Adelaide, SA 5000.
